

Taking a shot at Lyme disease.....

Pfizer and Valneva (French pharma company) has announced that its VLA15 vaccine is entering the third phase of a clinical study to help combat Lymes. Lyme disease can be debilitating and is a very real threat here on Nantucket. Due to this, the clinical study is looking to begin work here on Nantucket as well as the Vineyard! Some of you may have noticed a large trailer that was in the parking lot next to the main building labeled Care Access not too long ago. While the trailer is gone, we continue to work with Care Access, a company working with Pfizer and Valneva on the clinical study, to TRY to utilize the Sherburne site (inside Sherburne House) to be able to bring the Lyme disease trial to Nantucket. The same company is working with Briarpatch (one of the companies that leases space in Sherburne House) at their location off island and that is how the idea of 'setting up shop' at Sherburne came about. We are happy to try and help such an important study be conducted in the Nantucket community and will work hard to ensure minimal disruption to our Residents.
